(*A*) Nondisjunction in the first division of meiosis (meiosis stage I). (*B*) Nondisjunction in the second division of meiosis (meiosis stage II). (*C*) What happens if an egg with the pattern from the *left* part of *A* participates in sexual reproduction. (*D*) What happens if an egg with the pattern from the *right* part of *B* participates in sexual reproduction.
