(A) The heritability of morphological and life history traits (red and blue circles, respectively) decreases with the correlation between the trait and fitness. The magenta dots show the heritability of fitness itself, which is estimated as near 0 in both sexes. (B) A similar plot for the additive genetic variance standardized relative to the square of the mean ( $CV_A$ ). Total fitness has near-zero  $CV_A$  in females (lower magenta dot) but high  $CV_A$  in males (upper magenta dot).
