

FIGURE 26.10. Genetic and linguistic boundaries correspond closely across Europe. The *red* lines indicate average gradients in allele frequency from a survey of 60 alleles at 3119 locations. These were used to estimate 33 zones of sharp genetic change, indicated by the *purple lines*. Of these, all but two correspond to linguistic boundaries. Boundaries shown in the sea are between adjacent land masses (e.g., Ireland vs. Iceland).
